### Music Notes

The tune to our closing hymn – Nettleton – is a shaped note tune first published in Wyeth's Repository of Sacred Music in 1813. The Repository listed it as an Anonymous composition. The tune was named to honor Asahel Nettleton (1783-1844), a well-known evangelist who published a hymnal with texts only. There is no evidence that he ever composed any music. We know the Nettleton tune most often to the text "Come thou fount of every blessing." However, it is often used with a wide variety of texts as we see (and sing) today.
