Music Notes: We welcome Jen Hommez as our Offertory soloist today.

The prelude is by Johannes Brahms (1833-1897) and postlude by Felix Mendelssohn (1809-1847). When Mendelssohn died Brahms was still living at home, building his reputation as a fine pianist and not yet focused composing music. Later in life Brahms collected rare books and music scores. We know a prized possession was the composer's autograph copy of a sacred work by Mendelssohn. The two had much in common on compositional approach and musical vocabulary – both rooted in history and the methods used by Bach and early German composers. Today their music is often programmed together in symphonic and solo concerts.
