Stewardship: Building a Culture of Gratitude

Today in our worship service, we continue our stewardship campaign and consider how to nurture gratitude in our lives. We also welcome **Bruce Whitaker**, long-time member of Redeemer, who will give the first of three stewardship "Temple Talks". Music Notes: Today's prelude and postlude are settings of hymns from the ELW. They are also examples of tunes used for multiple texts. As we've discussed before, hymns are written in two parts – the words and the music. In the case of these hymns the poets wrote the text and then went looking for a tune that fit the rhythm of the poem. The prelude tune -- Liebster Jesu, wir sind hier – we have with three different texts. ELW 520, has the text "Dearest Jesus at your word," ELW 510 "Word of God come down on earth", and ELW 343, "Dearest Jesus, we are here." The postlude -- Sonne der Gerechtigkeit – occurs twice at ELW 657 "Rise, O Son of righteousness" and the Easter text ELW 362 "At the Lamb's high feast we sing." Since both tunes are long-standing in the Lutheran tradition – one from the 16th century and the other from the 17th – the poets chose their tunes wisely.
