Music Notes:

Today's prelude and postlude come from the Great Awakening Revivals of the 19th Century. Fanny J. Crosby (1820-1915) was one of the most prolific gospel hymn-writers of the era. We know of more than 8,000 texts she wrote. Sometimes

she wrote the poem and someone composed music for it later. Blessed Assurance came out of a meeting with her friend Florence Knapp who played the tune for her and asked what it said to her. Fanny immediately responded with the first phrase of the text.

Hiding Place composer, Joshua Leavitt (1794-1873), was a lawyer and Minister. After graduating Yale Seminary and serving a Congregational Church in Stratford, CT, he moved to New York and began a career publishing *The Christian Lyre*, editing journals and being a very active Abolitionist. He formed the Committee to raise funds for the defense of the Amistad captives, helped at least one slave to escape to Massachusetts, founded the New York Anti-Slavery Society and was the first Secretary of the American Temperance Society. He was active in the revival movement as musical adviser to Charles Grandison Finney, the most famous preacher of the Second Great Awakening.

Most needed items include: Supermarket Gift Cards, Canned Meat & Fish, Canned Pastas, Stews, Chilis and Hearty Soups, Canned Tomatoes and Vegetables, Pasta, White and Brown Rice, Dried Beans, Cold Cereal, Oatmeal, Pancake Mix, Peanut Butter & Jelly, Shelf Stable Milk, Baby Formula, Diapers (Size 4, 5, 6), Toilet Paper and Paper Towels, Low Sodium and Low Sugar Foods, Cleaning products & Laundry Detergent, Toothpaste, Shampoo & Body Wash, and Coffee. **Donations can also be dropped off at the Ramsey Farmers Market on Sunday 9am-2pm at the Main Street Train Station, Ramsey.**
